

# MTFIDA Action Plan Update June 2023



## Accessibility

Completion of Multi-Use Path on Chilliwack River Road from Chilliwack River Road to Bailey Road

Accessible playground installed at the Chilliwack Landing, designed to offer unique play value and experiences for children of all ages and abilities through Universal Design principles.

In 2023, replacing over 1,200 orange HPS lights with new, more visible LED lights throughout the City.

## Accessibility

Three new audible pedestrian crossings added in 2022.

Over 10 new Bulldog “Beeping” style push buttons installed at intersections in 2022.

New addition at City Hall built to meet or exceed current accessibility standards.

## Truth and Reconciliation

Partnered with Chilliwack Healthier Community and Stó:lō Service Agency to host an educational event about First Nations and Métis cultures. Also supported by Chilliwack Community Services and Chilliwack Métis Association.

Staff are reviewing 2040 OCP Design Guidelines for common amenity areas within multi-unit developments to ensure Universal Design principles are used for playground areas

## Funding Opportunities

Inclusive events and activities continue to be funded through the Neighbourhood Grant Program and Community Development Initiatives funding, including funding for the annual Pride Festival, and the 2023 Streams free Spring Feast and Dinner.

## Staff Education

Provided letters of support for Chilliwack Chamber of Commerce in their application for the Regional Community to Community Program funding through UBCM. Under the grant, City staff are eligible to receive additional training.

Participated in Indigenous Cultural Safety Training by the Chilliwack Chamber of Commerce under the C2C program, led by Len Pierre at LenPierreConsulting.com in March 2023.
