

Each collection area is divided into two 'zones' for garbage and glass collection. Garbage and glass are collected BI-WEEKLY from Zone A one week and Zone B the next.



Missed Collection?

- All homes are served by multiple trucks. Recycling, compostables, garbage, and glass trucks arrive at different times to pick up different materials.
- Please place materials at the curb by 7 am and leave out until 5 pm. Collection times can change without notice.

- Every home has one free size Green Cart exchange.
- Additional size changes can be made anytime for \$25.

Moving or Damaged Cart?

- If you are moving do not take your Green Cart, Blue Bin, or Grey Bin with you. Please contact the City if your home does not have containers.
- Additional or replacement Blue Bins and Grey Bins are available at City Hall for a fee.
- Residents are required to supply their own garbage bins (121L max.).

Tag-a-Bag Stickers & Purchase Locations

- Homes setting out more than two bags or cans (121L ea.) of garbage need to affix a purple Tag-a-Bag sticker to additional bags or cans to ensure collection.
- In addition to the Green Cart, residents may place up to 10 extra paper yard waste bags or bundles of branches year-round.
- Need a green Tag-a-Bag Sticker. All Tag-a-Bag stickers must be affixed where visible to the crew. Garbage \$2.10 each & Yard Waste \$1.85 each.







GREEN CART TIPS

SIZE & WEIGHT LIMITS



Not available as of Sept 2023



Please do not put sod, rocks, soil or dirt into the carts



Strain excess liquid and only place the solid pieces in the cart.




Biodegradable or compostable coffee pods, utensils, cups or any materials with BPI or compostable/biodegradable labeling are not accepted in Green Carts.



Ensure snow is cleared and that cart placement will not interfere with snow plows or other vehicles. Remove any snow and ice off the lids.



The contents of your Green Cart may freeze to the sides or bottom of the cart. Crews performing the collection will attempt to dump the entire contents of your Green Cart, but material may be stuck.



You may also put up to 10 bags (15kg/33lbs) or bundles of yard waste out for collection with your Green Cart at no extra cost.



Store your Green Cart in your garage or another shady spot during warm weather.



Don't force the contents of the cart down.



If grass clippings are sticking to your cart, consider putting them in a paper yard waste bag first and then roll up the bag, or lining your cart with newspaper.



Always have your cart out by 7 a.m.



Get to know your neighbours and offer your assistance.



You are responsible for taking care of your cart and keeping it clean from odours, dirt, pests, and insects.



Please do not use plastic bags/liners.

- Use only paper or newspaper to line your cart.
- Plastic bags/liners, including those marked compostable/biodegradable, are not accepted in your cart because they do not breakdown.
