Let's get food waste out of our garbage! The City of Chilliwack is planning changes to our Residential Curbside Collection Program in 2017 to separate food waste for composting. Redirecting valuable organic material from the landfill to more beneficial use is part of a region-wide effort that will ultimately involve all sectors.

Over the next few months, City staff will be reaching out to residents to

False Alarm Bylaw



The City of Chilliwack is implementing an automated billing system to invoice property owners for false alarms which will come into full effect in September 2015.

What is a false alarm?

A false alarm is the activation of an alarm system resulting in the attendance of the

RCMP or the Fire Department at the property when there is no apparent or actual evidence to merit such a call. (See Bylaw No. 3747 for a full description online under Regulatory Bylaws.)

Why is the City implementing this bylaw?

Starting in September 2015, the City will invoice property owners for false alarms to encourage people to reduce false alarms, which cause an unnecessary expense and take RCMP members or fire fighters away from real emergencies.
